

The Story

The Trust was formed in 1993. The Trust primarily provides support for the ministries of Henry Morgan, Sylvia Morgan, Paul Booth, Julian Maddock and Roy Gregory. A larger group of people meet regularly to encourage each other and have conversations in the area of Spirituality. The Trust has recently sponsored the 'Approaches to Prayer' website which can be accessed from the trust's website.

The Trust also supports the work of 'Soul Space' at the Greenbelt Christian Arts Festival and the Prayer Cards used there are available from our website.

We also support the work of Spirited Exchanges UK which helps those whose faith journey is outside the church.

The Trust has an ethos based around the annunciation story (Luke 1: 26-38). This tells of a young woman hearing a call from God, which both terrifies and excites her, but sustained by God she accepts it.

The story speaks both to our own condition and to the ministry to which we find ourselves called, outside the formal structure of the Christian church: a ministry of helping men and women discern their own calling from God, and to follow it.
